## Significant variances 2017-18

- Line 2 Precept £3000 in 2016/17, £4600 in 2017/18, (+£1600 = +53%). Precept in 2016/17 should have been £3600. Reduced by £600 due to administrative error that year which was overlooked and not corrected. At £3600 precept proving insufficient:
  - 1. With no spare funds with which to fund any improvements for the parish
  - 2. Without provision for erosion of the value of the precept attributable to increasing prices historically and going forward.
  - 3. Without consideration of the possibility that, at some point, the government will introduce the previously threatened referendum requirement.

Precept for 2017/18 fully considered and budgeted for and precept increased to realistic figure of  $\pounds$ 4600.

 Line 3 – Total other receipts 2016-17 = £6001 2017-18 = £1855

Significant difference  $(-\pounds4146 = -70\%)$  attributable to:

- 1. Donations/grants received in 2016-17 totalled £6000 for a village sign project. In 2017-18 grants totalled £1787 (- £4213)
- 2. No rent received 2016/17. Rent received in 2017/18 was £68 (+£68)
- 3.  $+\pounds4213-\pounds68 = \pounds4145$ .
- Line 5 Staff costs 2016-17 = £3102 2017-18 = £2159Significant difference (-£943 = -30%) attributable to transition period in 2016-17 between appointment of new clerk and former clerk's retirement during which time there were two clerks. This was not a factor in 2017-18.
